It provides a flat, uniformly absorbent for surface preparation of all Spectrum Acrylic Paints and Spectrum Acrylic Stucco Finishes. It is a must use overcoat application for Spectrum Base Coat, Spectrum Fiber Reinforced Scratch & Brown, and Spectrum Gray Finish Coat. Spectrum Primer will provide a more uniform, color background and adhesive surface. Spectrum Primer comes with a 5 year limited material warranty.

General information

Spectrum Primer can be used on sheetrock, wood-based sheathings, metal, stucco and any cementitious surface (stucco, block, poured concrete and masonry surfaces). Please note that Spectrum Primer must be applied over uncured cementitious materials to ensure that improper PH levels do not cause coating failures or shadowing issues. Clean area and remove all dust, grease, oil, paint, dirt, efflorescence and any unsound concrete. Thoroughly mix primer to a smooth, homogeneous consistency before application. Do not over mix or introduce air into the coating. Please note that you should not apply primer coating when the temperature outside is lower than 40 degrees Fahrenheit or when frost is predicted. Do not use in wet areas and protect work from rain for at least 4 hours.

All coverages are approximate, dependent on substrate and individual application techniques.
Spectrum Primer: 1500 sq. ft. - 2400 sq. ft.
Tintable Primer: 1500 sq. ft.
